Final Judge: Jan Beatty

Jan Beatty's fourth full-length book, *The Switching/Yard*, was published by the University of Pittsburgh Press in February 2013. Other books include *Red Sugar*, finalist for the 2009 Paterson Poetry Prize; *Boneshaker*, finalist, Milton Kessler Award; and *Mad River*, Agnes Lynch Starrett Prize—all published by the University of Pittsburgh Press. A limited edition chapbook, *Ravage*, was published by Lefty Blondie Press in 2012. Another chapbook, *Ravenous*, won the 1995 State Street Prize. Beatty's *New and Selected Poems* is forthcoming from University of Pittsburgh Press in Spring 2017. Other awards include the \$15,000 Creative Achievement Award in Literature from the Heinz Foundation, the Pablo Neruda Prize for Poetry, Discovery/The Nation Prize finalist, and two fellowships from the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts.
